

Opposite top: Nestled among boulders and vegetation high on a hillside, this brick-accented spa sends water over an opening in its edge and into an adjoining pool on a lower level.

Opposite bottom: Designed to draw the eye out to the Tucson foothills, this award-winning pool and detached spa from Patio, Pools & Spas are both finished with Caribbean Blue Pebble Tec®. The pool features travertine seat walls and front and back negative edges.

Above: Presidential Pools & Spas designed this Grecian-shaped pool—with its curves and cut-outs—using a Kona Blue Pebble Radiance™ finish that boasts iridescent glass beads and abalone shells. A sun shelf, water woks, and a waterfall with a 3-foot sheer descent add to the magic.
